

WSRBA Youth Achievement Program

- Open to any WSRBA Youth member
- Begins August 1 and ends July 31 of the following year
- 1 year to completion
- 10 projects, must complete 8 different within the year to achieve recognition at next year's State convention banquet
- Must be signed off by a member of the national team or Royalty committee, by the board of Directors, or a show superintendant
- Suggestions for projects
 - Volunteer to sort cards at a WSRBA sanctioned show
 - Write for a judge for ½ day at a WSRBA sanctioned show
 - Make an educational display or poster to display at a show
 - This could be a PowerPoint, poster, or 3D model
 - Create a learning activity to be presented to the other WSRBA youth at a show
 - Participate in an ARBA youth contest other than Royalty or the National Teams
 - This could include management, achievement, educational displays or arts and crafts
 - Perform a showmanship demonstration for beginner level members at a WSRBA show
 - Attend a WSRBA Board Meeting or Judges Conference and write a one page summary of your experiences
 - Write a short article for a WSRBA bulletin – topics can include
 - Interviewing an open member
 - Writing about your experiences as a youth member
 - Writing about your breed and your experiences with that breed
 - Writing about a health or care topic
 - Volunteer to help setup or teardown for a show with a nearby rabbit club
 - Create your own topic, to be preapproved by a youth director. Topics include
 - 4H Rabbit Project **Leadership** activities
 - Meat or pelt processing
 - Obtaining your registrar's license
 - Publishing an article for Domestic Rabbits magazine
 - Get creative and have your idea approved!
