

WSRBA Youth Liaison Requirements
And
Application Instructions

1. The applicant must be a current member in good standing with the WSRBA at time of application submission.
2. The applicant must be at least 14 years of age as of January 1, 2014. In addition, applicant should not reach their 19th birthday during the liaison term period they are appointed to.
3. The Youth Liaison representative serves for a period two (2) years and is appointed by the WSRBA Board. The Youth Liaison will be a team effort with two youth in the position. In 2014 there will be a one year term and a two year term but only in 2014.
4. Attendance by the Youth Liaison to the quarterly board meeting of the WSRBA is MANDATORY. The WSRBA is not responsible for providing transportation to or from the WSRBA quarterly meetings. Transportation is the responsibility of the Youth Liaison at his/her own cost.
5. The parents/guardian of the applicant supports the applicant's pursuit of the Youth Liaison position; and will continue to support the applicant during their term if appointed.
6. A completed WSRBA Youth Liaison application is defined as the youth liaison application form set forth below. Additional pages may be added to the application to complete the answer to the application.
7. I understand that if I am appointed to serve as the Youth Liaison I agree to act in a responsible manner at all rabbit related activities, shows and events at any location as I am representing the youth of the WSRBA.
8. The WSRBA reserves the right to remove the Youth Liaison from his/her position for good cause as determined by the WSRBA Board.
9. The Youth Liaison must reside within the state.
