The following breeds will start in Open: Angoras, Checkered Giant, Polish, Flemish Giant, French Lop, Californian, Holland Lop, Netherland Dwarf, Mini Satin, Mini Rex and Cavies(American). Following breeds for Open will be: American Fuzzy Lop, Rhinelander, Britannia Petite, American Chinchilla, English Lop, Crème d Argent, Mini Lop, Dwarf Hotot, Satin & New Zealand. Starting and following breeds are subject to change based on entry counts. Youth starting breeds will be determined the day of the show based on the status of the Youth Contests. This will allow for our youth members to focus on the contests and still be able to show their own animals at State Convention. Youth rabbits will be judged starting at 10:00 a.m.

Awards

Trophies will be awarded for Best 4 Class, Best 6 Class, Best Overall in Show (Open & Youth).

All Best of Breeds and Best Opposite of Breeds, Open & Youth, Rabbit & Cavy, with ten or more show in the breed, will receive a rosette. All Best of Breed Winners will be put into a drawing for a WSRBA Apron.

Show Rules:

- 1. This show will be governed by the latest revised rules of the ARBA, and the completion of the entry blank indicates your acceptance of these rules and those rules listed in the catalog.
- 2. The WSRBA will not be responsible in case of fires, accident or providential destruction. Every precaution will be taken to prevent the same.
- 3. All pre-entries must be postmarked by August 30, 2024. Online Entries deadline September 5, 2024.
- 4. All entries should be on official blanks printed in this catalog; however, entries will be accepted on other forms like the one published on the WSRBA Website. Remark cards will not be used for pre-entries.
- 5. A check or money order must accompany your entry. Entries will not be valid without the proper payment.
- 6. Please make all checks and money orders payable to the: Wisconsin State Rabbit Breeders Association.

- 8. Open & youth pre-entry fees for the **convention show** are: single rabbit or cavy & meat pen \$8.00 both shows and \$5.00 each show; fur class \$2.00 each show.
- 9. Open & youth show-day entry fees for the State <u>Convention show</u> are single rabbit or cavy & meat pen-\$9.00; fur class \$4.00. Remark Cards are required for day of show entries. All starting breeds close at 8:00 a.m. the day of the show, with all other breeds closing at 10:00 a.m. the day of the show.
- 10. Open & Youth show-day entry fees for the Sunday show are single rabbit or cavy & meat pen \$5.00; fur class \$3.00. Remark Cards are required for day of show entries.
- 11. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly marked in the left ear.
- 12. All fur entries must be entered and in the paid regular class.
- 13. Banquet tickets must be ordered and PAID for at the time of entry.
- 14. Substitutions for the state convention show will be allowed for a FEE of \$2.00 per rabbit, no fee on fur substitutions. All substitutions for starting breeds must be in by 8:00 a.m. the day of the show, with all other breeds closing by 10:00 a.m. the day of the show. Substitutions must be made within the same class you pre-entered. Any other change will be considered a day-of-show entry. Ear numbers cannot be changed on the Control Sheets at the table without first reviewing the original entry sheet and/or substitution sheet.
- 15. Any change made to an entry at the show table will be disqualified unless it is approved by the Superintendent or Secretary of the Show.
- 16. Only authorized persons will be allowed behind the judges' tables.
- 17. We reserve the right to substitute judges or to add judges if the need arises. Every effort will be taken to follow the printed show schedule.
- 18. Ribbons will be awarded to third place. Ribbons and trophies will not be mailed. Please pick yours up before leaving the show. Cash specials will be mailed.
- 19. Breed Chairpersons are responsible for obtaining writers for both Open and Youth on Sunday.
- 20. Judging will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. with the opening breeds listed on the second page of the show catalog. Refer to the second page of this catalog for special provisions regarding the youth show order and starting times. Youth judging will begin at 10:00 a.m.
- 21. All four and six class breeds and cavies will be judged on Saturday, and with a single, all-breed show on Sunday. SEE ATTACHED FLYER FOR DETAILS OF THE SUNDAY ALL-BREED SHOW.
- 22. Double WSRBA sweepstakes points will be awarded for the convention (Saturday) show only. Single WSRBA sweepstake points will be awarded for Sunday's show.
- 23. Fifty cents (\$0.50) of each open and youth entry will be used for next years' specials on each breed.
- 24. From each entry: ten cents (\$0.10) will go to the WSRBA sweepstakes fund, two cents (\$0.02) will go to the Sweepstakes Chairman, and three cents (\$0.03) will go to the Bulletin.
- 25. Youth Members must carry youth rabbits to the show table, with the exception of youth contest participants while contests are still running.

Directions to Fairgrounds

- From the North Hwy 41 South to the Hwy 151 exit. Take highway 151 North. Turn left onto Martin Ave. Follow Martin Ave. to the Fairgrounds on the right.
- From the South Hwy 41 North to Hwy 151 exit. Turn right onto Hwy 151 (North). Follow Hwy 151 to Hwy 45. Right (North) onto Hwy 45 and follow to Fairgrounds which will be on the left.
- **From the East** Hwy 23 West to National Ave. Turn left onto National Ave. and follow to Hwy 45. Turn right (North) onto Hwy 45 and follow to the Fairgrounds on the left.
- From the West Hwy 23 East to Pioneer Rd. Right onto Pioneer Rd., go to the 6th light and turn left onto Martin Ave. Follow to the Fairgrounds on the right.
